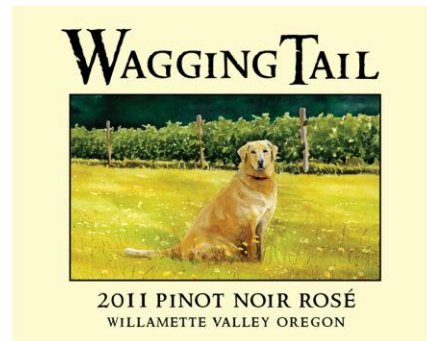


## 2011 Wagging Tail Pinot Noir Rose´

*113 cases produced*

### Tasting Notes

This fun and frisky wine has generous aromas of strawberries and rose petals. A light entry gives way to strawberry soda flavors that evolve into a bright and prickly finish. Try pairing this wine chilled with spicy Asian dishes or a hot tub.



### Winemaker Notes

The Wagging Tail Rose´ was created by taking juice from several of our Pinot Noir fermenters after 24 hours of skin contact time. The pink juice was settled and racked to tank and inoculated with W15 yeast and fermented until 1% residual sugar remained. The wine was sulfured and then cold and heat stabilized for the next several months. Carbon Dioxide was injected into the wine to add a fun and crisp element to the palate. Sterile filtration and bottling occurred on March 29<sup>th</sup> of 2012.
