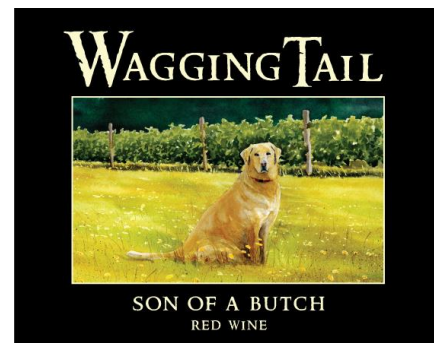


## Wagging Tail – Son of a Butch Red Wine

### Tasting Notes

Aromas of dark cherry, plums, rose petals, and blackberries meld with whiffs of oak and allspice. A silky entry gives way to a rich mouthfeel of fine grained tannins that let you know that this dog will hunt. This wine is begging to be enjoyed with food so unleash this puppy at the barbeque where it's dark, rich textures will pair nicely with caramelized hunks of grilled goodness.



### Winemaker Notes

“Son of a Butch” is a dark red blend of several tasty varietals that will make your tail wag for sure. This wine is dedicated the memory of our Labrador, Butch, who was loved by all who knew him. In 2011, this 2<sup>nd</sup> generation blend is Pinot Noir, Syrah and Tempranillo. The Pinot is from the Willamette Valley and the Syrah comes from Washington and definitely adds a depth and viscosity to the wine. We also added the Washington Tempranillo to the blend in order to fetch the aromas and flavors of red strawberry fruits and plums.

**Willamette Valley Pinot Noir - 20%**

**Washington Syrah - 35%**

**Washington Tempranillo - 45%**

Aged in Oregon and French Oak barrels
